

HONDURAS MISSION APPLICATION PART 3

Christ the King Honduras Mission Conduct Policy

All Missionaries are expected to conduct themselves and exhibit behavior appropriate to a Christian missionary. We are representing Christ the King Catholic Church and it is important to portray the image of Christ to the Honduran people.

The Honduras Mission Board of Directors, to ensure the safety and success of our mission, has established the following rules. Failure to follow the policy may jeopardize your selection for future missionary trips.

1. No missionary under the age of 21 years of age is allowed to drink alcoholic beverages at any time while on the mission. **No exceptions, even with parental consent.**
2. Missionaries are expected to attend scheduled activities including prearranged meals unless excused by the Mission Director.
3. [Alternative meal arrangements need to be pre-approved by the Mission Director.](#)
4. All missionary teams should return to the hotel by dark each workday.
5. Missionaries should be at the hotel by 10:00 p.m. each day.
6. **No one is to enter any nightclubs or bars in Trujillo.**
7. Travel in groups of 3 or more especially to and from work sites, and in Trujillo
8. No business is to be conducted for personal gain while in Honduras.
9. As missionaries acknowledge that their actions and attitude while on the mission are intended to be a reflection of Jesus Christ and Christ the King Catholic Church in Little Rock. As such, each member agrees to place themselves under the authority of the director and the policies of the mission during the missionary trip.
