

# **CTK Honduras Mission 2012**

## **Important – Please read before applying**

**In 2012 we will once again sending two mission groups to Honduras. The first mission trip will be in March, during Spring break, and our regular mission group will go in June. It is important that you understand the differences in these 2 trips before you apply.**

**The spring mission focuses on education, evangelization and construction. The dates are March 17 to 25. This trip will be limited to 20 to 24 missionaries who will stay at Casa Alamania, a small hotel located on the beach in Trujillo. This trip is less expensive than the summer mission. This missionary team will be composed of:**

- **Physician, surgeon, and nurses who want to teach and work with local medical professionals**
- **teachers and teens for the school team**
- **construction workers**
- **an evangelization team consisting of a priest, team leader, and teens with leadership abilities.**

**The spring mission does not provide medical care to the villages, however, we will provide follow-up to our chronic patients at the local clinics.**

**The summer mission will be held from June 9 to 17, with about half the group traveling a day early on June 8. This is our large medical mission with 90 to 95 missionaries staying at the Christopher Columbus Hotel in Trujillo. Medically we operate 3 village clinics, an eye clinic, and dental clinic. The hospital team holds clinics and their operating room team performs around 60 surgeries. Our school team and hearing team work in our schools and the construction team works on projects at our schools and churches. Evangelization is provided by our bilingual priest and missionaries in partnership with local delegados at all clinic sites. Encuentros are held to train the local delegados.**

**Missionaries will be selected based on their experience and skills related to the needs of the mission. There is a job for everyone!**
